# 台澳學術交流合作計畫赴澳洲考察訪問報告

傳播學門:(邵)翁秀琪

### 壹、計劃說明

台灣與澳洲同屬廣泛的太平洋區域,雖然地處一南一北,面積大小不等,但 兩者在族群組成上卻有相似的背景,即同屬移民社會與多元文化的國家,境內也 都有相當比例的原住民族。在區域地理政治的考量上,兩者也同樣重視東南亞國 家及中國大陸的研究與政策分析。有鑑於此,在 2009 年 3 月 19 日,由澳洲社會 科學院透過駐台澳洲工商辦事處提議,經國科會人文處協調,邀集台灣社會科學 研究者共同商討與澳洲學術界進行合作交流的可能性。在參考澳方提議的 27 項 研究主題後(參見原計畫書附件一),6 名台灣學者提出 10 類可能的合作研究方 向(參見原計畫書附件二)。為進一步瞭解台澳雙方合作研究的可能性,由澳方 與國科會安排,邀請台灣學者於 5 月 25 日赴澳進行為期 7-10 天的考察訪問活動。 其主要目的,即是根據台灣學者提出的可能合作議題,拜訪澳洲相關的研究機構 及學者,進行第一步的實際接觸與理解。(請參見劉紹華,2009,p.1)

#### 貳、訪問行程

2009年5月25日至6月3日,共10天,各領域學者依拜訪目的及單位的不同,時程上略有調整。行程安排如下:


